International Sustainability Accreditation Awarded to Australian Tyre Recycler

Entyr Limited has earned international accreditation from the respected International Sustainability and Carbon Certification Association (ISCC) acknowledging its contribution to a circular economy and to reducing GHG emissions.

The certification endorses the production of high quality recovered carbon black (eCB) and tyre-derived-fuel-oil (eTDFO) from the thermal desorption of end-of-life tyres - replacing the need for virgin resources and lowering GHG emissions in the manufacturing process.

“This accreditation is significant for many reasons. It not only validates that we are actively contributing to the decarbonisation of infrastructure, but it confirms that our processes are sustainable,” said Entyr CEO David Wheeley.

“We are at the beginning of our transition into full commercialisation after 12 years of scientific research. ISCC certification supports our expansion strategy to apply our technology globally, turning one of the world’s biggest waste issues into a complete circular economy solution,” said Mr Wheeley.

The ISCC is one of the world’s largest certification system assessing organisations on the production of biomass and other raw materials in an environmentally, socially, and economically sustainable manner. It is an independent multi-stakeholder initiative governed by more than 220 members including research institutes and NGOs and supports the UN Sustainable Development Goals

“We know our technology and process is unique - our patents tell us that - but for our team and shareholders, this certification is also an endorsement of our ethics and values,” said Mr Wheeley.
